bob dawson



Bob Dawson (1921-2012) was an independently celebrated British sculptor of the 20th Century. Born in Holywell, North Wales, his sculptures are directly linked to memories of his childhood and his intimate relationship to nature.

Throughout his lifetime, his sculptures continued to evolve, using a range of materials such as bronze, stone and clay in an organic manner; carving them into strangely shifting forms and achieving a complex patina of surfaces.

The artist believed that his sculptures were primarily concerned with life, its' shifting and changing nature, which is in constant flux: the cycle of conception, growth, decline, death and rebirth. It is the eternal cycle, of which we are part of, and the human courage to go on living despite its hardships and weathering, that inspired him most.

Join his daughter Alison who will be opening up the studio for the public to enjoy Bob's work.
